The 35th ANNUAL CARRY NATION FESTIVAL is September 6th and 7th, 2008 in beautiful Downtown Holly.

We are working hard on the 2008 Festival, and extending an invitation for you to participate. Below is a list of general information regarding the festival. We hope you can join us.

Enclosed you will find all the materials you will need to participate. All applications are due by August 15, 2008. No refunds of booth rental will be granted after August 25, 2008. You will receive your booth assignment by August 29, 2008. With your application, please provide photos of your product (other than produce) and display (if you haven't participated before), proof of insurance (if applicable) and payment. Applications will be processed on a first come, first serve basis.

1. Booths will be 10' x 10'. We require that all tables be skirted and covered.
\$35 per booth/per day - \$50 for the weekend.

Vendors/Farmers are encouraged, but not required to dress in early 1900 period clothing. Carry Nation visited Holly in 1908. The public is very fond of the spirit the Festival brings; the more you can join in the festivities, the better the Festival!

CONDITIONS OF THE FESTIVAL

1. All materials are juried. The Carry Nation Festival reserves the right to limit crafters with the same product.
2. All fees and charges are represented in this contract. Photographs to include with this contract are to be current. Exhibitors may only show work typified by current photos submitted.
3. An application is commitment to show. No refunds will be given after August 14, 2008.
4. All exhibits must be removed by 6:00pm the last day of the festival.
5. **NO MOTOR VEHICLES** will be permitted to enter the festival area beyond the road barriers set-up/established/maintained by the Holly Police Station.
6. Exhibitors must have their booth staffed at all times during the hours of the festival.
 - a. Saturday, September 6, 2008 from 9am-6pm
 - b. Sunday, September 7, 2008 from 11am-4pm
7. You are welcome to remain open until 9:00pm Saturday evening, but not required to do so.
8. Only one exhibitor per booth.
9. The Carry Nation Festival will exercise every possible care and precaution, but will not be responsible for any loss, damage, injury or legal action that may arise to any participating vendor, vendor's employees, agents, or property. Vendor agrees to save and hold the Carry Nation Festival and its volunteer committee members harmless from such liability.
10. All Vendors/Service Providers/Participants must have a signed and dated Waiver of Liability Form in order to participate.
11. The collection and payment of any and all Sales Tax is the sole responsibility of the Vendor/Exhibitor.
12. Each food and commercial vendor display must provide proof of insurance. The proof of insurance must accompany your application.
13. **ONLY PERSON** and/or **COMPANIES** that have applied to and have been approved by the Carry Nation Festival Committee shall be included and/or approved to operate under the Carry Nation Festival, Village of Holly Festival Permit. Any other person and/or organization must make a separate application in order to legally sell food within the Village of Holly.
14. Each vendor must supply at least (2) garbage containers. Each vendor shall be required to keep any assigned area clean of all garbage and/or debris, and waste must be disposed of periodically. Festival dumpsters will be available. Absolutely no garbage is to be left on the site after the vendor leaves the festival. The Village of Holly will fine any person(s) for trash left in the area.
15. It is the vendors' responsibility to obtain a temporary food service license. Contact must be made with the Oakland County Health Division for an application. Each vendor shall be required to display said license. All Health Department codes are the responsibility of the vendor. A vendor without a license will be shut down.
16. If a vendor is shut down for any reason, no refunds will be given.
17. Each vendor must supply their own lead lines to reach outlets and electrical cords must be taped to the ground with quality duct tape if exposed.
